Secondary School Supplementary Form(s) will be available to collect from St. Mary's Church at the following times:

As you will be entering church, please wear a mask / face covering (unless exempt under the government guidelines) and please follow social distancing rules and keep 2m away from anyone else in church at the same time. There is no need to tell us when you

are coming - just turn up at church at one of the above sessions to suit you but, if everyone turns up at the same time, please be aware that we may ask you to socially distance queue outside church in order to keep everyone safe.

We will take your name and sign for the collection of the form(s) on your behalf (to avoid cross contamination between multiple people touching pens / paper). The forms will be arranged so that you only touch the one you are collecting and there will be plenty of hand gel for you to use as well.
